EVALUATION REPORT OF "KITZ CONQUEST"
BY A COMPANY 7TH GURKHA RIFLES

1. Kitz Conquest claims to:
 - a. Decarbonise weapons.
 - b. Repel insects/mosquitoes/leeches.
 - c. Medicate sores (germicidal).
 - d. Prevent foot + crotch rot (fungicidal).
2. These claims have been tested in the jungles of Brunei over a 5 months period. The subjective findings based on general experience by many users is favourable.
 - a. Decarbonise weapons. Reduces time to clean weapons heavily carbonised after firing blanks, especially GPMG's. No adverse effects were detected.
 - b. Insect repellent. It is reasonably effective as a mosquito repellent but does require frequent application. It can however be safely used in contact with plastics, optics and splashed over uniform which the issue repellent can not be. It is effective against leeches.
 - c. Germicidal. Works well on jungle cuts and sores and appears to aid and hasten the healing process.
 - d. Fungicidal. It has been used most effectively by several people for crotch and foot rot. It cleared a case of crotch rot with just two applications. It has been the only effective solution for one user who had multiple sores on his ankles, no other medication that he tried was found to work.
3. Conclusion. Kitz Conquest is in danger of appearing a multipurpose 'Jack of all trades'. It is not a particularly effective Mosquito repellent but it does decarbonise gas plugs well and has proved most effective in every case of fungal infection it has had to deal with.
